

FORT DEFIANCE STATE PARK

(221 acres)

Rugged woodlands compliment the surrounding gently rolling farmland. Trails, picnic areas and scenic overlooks help visitors relax and unwind in nature's peaceful beauty. Lush vegetation adds to the park's appeal.

While exploring the trails, visitors surround themselves with hawthorn, plum, locust and many species of oak. In the spring, slopes are speckled with trillium, bloodroot, hepatica and violets. A small prairie with native grasses and flowers, including the endangered prairie bush clover, thrives on a secluded knoll.

Trails: Hiking, equestrian, cross-country skiing; self-guided interpretive trail

Picnicking/Shelters: Picnic areas throughout the park; open shelter for first-come/first-served use

Lodge: Universally accessible, seasonal day use; available for reservation

Camping: 8 electric, 8 non-electric; non-modern
